

# Salve vs. Cream vs. Roll-On

## How to choose

- ✓ **For home:** Salves and creams are usually easiest to use when you have time to apply by hand.
- ✓ **For travel:** Roll-ons are compact and easy to keep in a bag, desk, car, or gym bag.
- ✓ **For larger areas:** Creams usually spread more easily than salves.
- ✓ **For a richer feel:** Salves usually feel thicker and more concentrated in texture.
- ✓ **For a simple daily routine:** Many customers keep a cream at home and a roll-on for daytime use.

- ✓ Do you want to apply by hand or use a rollerball?
